RULES & Guidelines:

Registration - A registration form must be completely filled out including name, age, address, phone number, e-mail address, all medical information and name of parent or guardian. A Copy of Competitive Students' birth certificate must be on file. You should notify us of any changes in information promptly. **You are not registered unless your registration fee and first tuition payment is paid in full.**

Payment – Tuition payments can to be made at the desk or by mail with personal check or cash.

- There are a total of 10 tuition payments for the dance season September thru June.
- Tuition #1 Registration fee and September tuition is due at time of registration.
- Tuition #2 thru #10 October thru June tuition is due by the 10th of each month for that month. We do not issue refunds.
- 5% discount for any group tuition paid in full for the fall season Sept. June when paid in full by October 30th.

Late Payment – A \$10.00 late fee will be applied to your tuition after the 10th of the month, balance after 30 days will also be subject to 24% interest annual finance charge. After 30 days the student will SIT out of class until payment is made in full. All classes must be paid regardless of attendance. There will be no exceptions. Family Discount students will not receive the family discount if not paid in full by the 10th of the month.

Check fee – Fee on any check returned by your bank is \$30.00. At this time all transactions must be paid in cash.

Hair and Attire - Hair must be secured tightly away from face. Students who ignore this rule will be asked to leave the class until they have complied. There will be no exceptions.

All students are required to wear appropriate attire. For girls, this means leotard and tights. Ballet students must wear black leotard, pink tights and pink shoes. Hair must be in a bun. For boys, hemmed shorts with shirt neatly tucked in. Proper footwear is also required. Ballet (pink); Boys (black ballet); Tap (black); Jazz (caramel).

Absolutely no gum, candy or beverages allowed in the classrooms. Students must be on time and ready when the class begins. No shirts will be allowed over leotards or in place of a leotard. No shorts are allowed over leotard or in place of leotard.

Parents Observation – Parents observation will be the first week of the month during the last 5- 10 minutes of class thru our observation windows beginning in November.

Other - We cannot be responsible for articles left in the dressing rooms or elsewhere. All dance shoes and cases should be marked with student's name. All valuables should be carried into the classroom. The instructor will designate where such articles may be placed during class. Bare feet will not be permitted, except under direct supervision of the teacher.

Studio closings Due to Weather Conditions—If schools are closed due to weather conditions or holidays it does not mean the studio will be closed. We will post cancellations/closures on our face book page, send emails & leave a message on our studio voicemail.

Costumes -

- Recreational Students: \$30.00 costume deposit is required per time slot
- Competition Team Students: \$50 costume deposit is required per time slot
- Costume deposits are due no later than October 30th. The remaining balance is due in November. Costumes will not be
 ordered if deposit and balance is not paid in full. Late Payment fees apply. Costume payments are made payable to
 CENTER STAGE. (Checks or Cash only No Credit Cards)

Special Classes – Private, semi-private, trio and small group instruction is available to students providing they take the minimum group dance classes per week, one of which must be ballet. There is a waiting list.

Dance Shoes & Attire - All Dance Supplies are recommended to be purchased at CENTER STAGE, our retail dance store, located inside KHSOD building. We can assure each dancer proper fit, correct shoe style and color needed for our end of season recital. Always priced at 20% below manufactures retail pricing.

Family Discounts

Family discounts apply to an individual or to cumulative classes of immediate family members that take a total of 3 or more group classes.

A credit slip to Center Stage will be issued at the end of each month to families based on 10% off the 3rd and more group class tuition.

These credit slips can be used only in Center Stage. You can use these towards all purchases: shoes, tights, clothing and even costumes!

(Credit slips expire 1 year from issued date)

In order to receive your family discount all accounts must be current, in good standing and paid in full by due date at both KHSOD and Center Stage.



FROM A DANCE PARENT: One of my friends asked "Why do you pay so much money and spend so much time running around for your daughter to dance?" Well I have a confession to make: I don't pay for my daughter's dance lessons. Or her pointe, ballet, jazz & tap shoes. Or her hundreds of costumes. So, if I am not paying for dance, what am I paying for? - I pay for those moments when my girl becomes so tired she feels like quitting but doesn't. - I pay for the opportunity that my girl can have and will have to make life-long friendships. - I pay for the chance that she may have amazing instructors that will teach her that dance is not just about movement but about life. - I pay for my child to learn to be disciplined. - I pay for my girl to learn to take care of her body. - I pay for my daughter to learn to work with others and to be a proud, supportive, kind and respectful team member. - I pay for my child to learn to deal with disappointment, when she doesn't get that score she hoped for, or fell during a move she has practiced a thousand times, but still gets up and is determined to do her BEST next time... - I pay for my girl to learn to make and accomplish goals. - I pay for my daughter to learn that it takes hours and hours and hours and hours of hard work and practice to create a champion, and that success does not happen overnight. - I pay so that my daughter can be in the studio instead of in front of a screen... I could go on but, to be short, I don't pay for dance; I pay for the opportunities that dance provides my child to develop attributes that will serve her well throughout her life and give her the opportunity to bless the lives of others.
